


Morning Nursery – Home Learning Activities

Here are activities for Nursery children in the event that Nursery is closed. Try one or more each day and repeat some of them throughout the week, if appropriate, to consolidate learning. Have fun!

<p>Sing Baa Baa Black Sheep. The sheep had three bags of wool. Practise counting out 3 objects using things from around the house e.g. ask your child to give you 3 bricks or 3 cars. Get them to count to check they have given 3 objects.</p>	<p>Watch some nursery rhymes with your child and sing along https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-songs-medleys/zr34bdm</p>	<p>Sing Hey Diddle Diddle. Pretend to be the cow and see how high you can jump with two feet together. Could you jump over the move? Then pretend to be the dish or the spoon and run around, avoiding obstacles and looking for spaces.</p>	<p>Sing Little Bo Peep. Draw or make 10 sheep and write a number on each one. Hide them around the room and ask your child to find them. Get your child to count them to check they are all there!</p> 	<p>Read the nursery rhyme booklet on the school website. As you say the rhymes, stop before you complete each line and see if your child can supply the missing words e.g. Incey Wincey..... climbed the water...</p>
<p>Sing Incey Wincey Spider. Find a paper plate or cut a circle out of cardboard. Ask your child to draw eyes and a mouth. Give your child 8 clothes pegs and ask them to clip them around the edge for legs.</p> 	<p>Let your child draw or paint pictures of their favourite nursery rhyme characters. Can they draw Incey Wincey or Baa Baa Black Sheep?</p> 	<h1 style="text-align: center; color: red;">Nursery Rhymes</h1>	<p>Sing The Wheels on the Bus. Draw an egg shape on a piece of paper, add a face and help your child to cut around it. Then cut the egg into jagged pieces and see if your child can put it back together like a jigsaw puzzle.</p> 	<p>Sing 5 Currant Buns.
