Dear Parents and Carers,

It is with our fingers crossed we share that the building work on our new hygiene and physio rooms (as well as the new Key Stage 2 link corridor) will begin as soon as we break up for the summer holidays. As this is such a large project, it will inevitably continue into the new academic year so we have to make some changes to our morning drop off and afternoon pick up arrangements which we share with you below.

The main area of disruption will be in the area adjacent to the Key Stage 2 link corridor and the museum area entrance. However, other areas of the school may face some disruption as we make adjustments to the exit and entry points and playground space.

From Wednesday 3rd September, morning 'drop off' and collection points will be as follows (please see the map attached to help you find out which entrance and exit your child will use):

Years 4 & 5

Children are to enter the back playground when the member of KS2 staff opens up the large double gates between the Nursery building and the cage area at 8.45am. Once you have dropped them off there, they will be supervised as they line up ready to enter their block from the back door. At the end of the day, the children will be brought back through at 3.30pm to meet parents at the same point.

Years 3 & 6

Children will only be able to enter the school through the main gate as the gate by the museum will not be in use. They will line up by the member of staff on the gate and will be taken in through the new outside door in the studio. Rather than having to take several items with them into school, Years 3 and 6 children who are having packed lunches will leave their lunches in a secure container at the front gate which will then be taken in so it is in the hall ready for lunchtime.

Nursery, Reception, Years 1 & 2 classes will stay the same

Breakfast Club and After-school Clubs

Entry to Breakfast Club in the studio will be through the new door which is going to be installed in the road end of the building.

At the end of After-school Club, the children will either come out of the new studio door for Chill Out or the front door for all other clubs.

Over the holidays, there will be a lot of other building work around the school as we have damp work and stone/brick reparations done as well. It's going to be a very busy summer so, understandably the school site will be completely closed. However, you can still get in touch with us via the school email address which we will monitor on a weekly basis.


We will endeavour to keep you updated throughout the project but should you have any questions please come and see us at the school gate.
