Dear Parents,

I am writing to let you know that on Thursday 21st May we plan to take a class trip to Hergest Croft Gardens. This will take place within the school day and links to our class topic of 'Come Outside' where we have been learning about different plants, their important parts and how they grow. Steve from Hergest Croft will be giving us a tour of the grounds and will talk to us about the different types of trees and plants they have.

We will be walking up to the gardens from school, so the children will need to wear comfortable footwear such as their trainers. We will also be staying for a picnic lunch, therefore the children will need to bring a packed lunch (**no nuts or chocolate spread that contains nuts to be included in the packed lunch please**) as well as their usual water bottle in a back pack that they can carry themselves. Please cancel any lunches booked.

The weather is currently looking to be fairly warm for Thursday, so please could we also ask that the children have sun cream applied in the morning before coming to school and bring along a sun hat to wear in case it is needed. The children should wear their Friday PE/Welly Walk clothes for the trip. Legs and arms should be fully covered regardless of the temperature to ensure protection from skin contact issues e.g. nettles. In case of any light showers, which we have seen a lot of recently, please could the children also have a light rain coat in school on this day.

We will walk back to school in time for the usual end of the day collection. If you have any questions or concerns then please do catch me at the gate or send a message via Tapestry.
