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Dear Parents and Carers,

Exciting New Changes to After-School Clubs Starting in September

We are delighted to share details of our new programme of low-cost after-school clubs, which will begin in September. These clubs will run alongside our usual Chill Out wrap-around care provision and have been designed to provide children with opportunities to develop new skills, pursue their interests, build confidence and, most importantly, have fun.

Over the year, we will be introducing a range of exciting clubs, but for the first half of the Autumn term, we will be offering:

- Monday – 3.30pm to 4.30pm Girls' Football for KS2 with Mrs Welson
- Wednesday – 3.30pm to 4.30pm Yoga for KS1 with Miss Tindale
- Friday – 3.30pm to 4.30pm Boys' Football for KS2 with Mr Ward-Willis

These clubs will cost £2 and run from 3.30pm to 4.30pm. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis as numbers are limited to 20 per club.

We would like to encourage our children to take part in at least one club over the year and make the most of the opportunities available. Participation in extra-curricular activities supports children's personal development, helps them make new friendships and enriches their overall school experience.

Our Chill Out club will run Monday to Friday from 3.30pm to 4.30pm for those wishing to book in for wrap-around child care, also at the cost of £2 a session. If your child stays from 4.30pm to 5pm and then 5pm to 5.30pm, it will be at a cost of £3.00 per half hour. Those children who attend other clubs are also able to book into the Chill Out club for the later sessions from 4.30pm if needed. Please contact the school office to arrange this. We are able to have up to 30 children in these clubs but we recommend you book in via Eduspot to avoid disappointment.

You can book all the clubs in the usual way on Eduspot. Please note the correct finish times when booking the Chill Out clubs. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

Thank you for your continued support. We look forward to seeing our pupils enjoy and benefit from these exciting new opportunities and will keep you updated with new clubs each half term.
